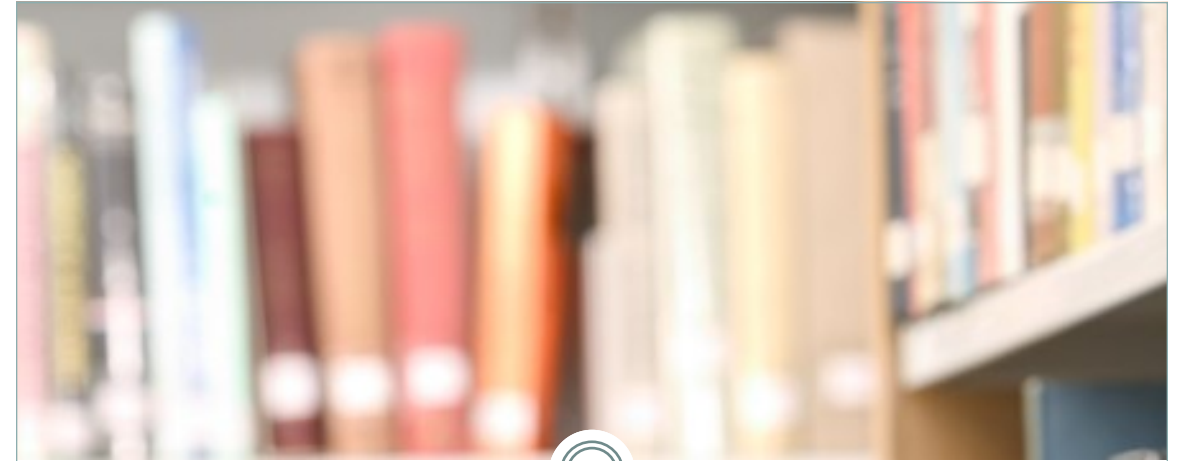
### What is a Campus Compact?
