Please find on the back, a copy of our Annual Student Residency Questionnaire.

The No Child Left Behind Act now requires Santa Fe ISD, along with other Local Education Agencies, to file an annual report with the federal government indicating the number of students who “lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence.”

We also must indicate those students who are classified as unaccompanied youth (youth who are not in the physical custody of a parent or court-appointed guardian).

Under Title I, the district receives limited federal funds, to help provide services to these eligible students under the McKinney-Vento Act. Once McKinney-Vento students have been identified, SFISD can offer them optional services (including free meals without the need of an application, ease in enrolling, referrals to community resources, various transportation options, etc.).
