Santa Fe ISD Bus Safety Stop Arm Enforcement Program

SFISD's first priority in the transportation program is the safety of our students. Santa Fe ISD and the City of Santa Fe are participating in a cooperative effort to improve the safety of students boarding and departing the school bus. In an effort to increase student safety, the City of Santa Fe passed an Ordinance in 2019, allowing for camera enforcement of school bus stop arm violations. SFISD currently has 10 buses with Stop Arm cameras.

Citations issued in October 2019

172 citations were issued over an 11 day period in October 2019, averaging 15.6 citations per day.



Citations issued in November 2019

209 citations were issued over a 16 day period in November 2019, averaging 13.1 per day.




Citations issued in December 2019

139 citations were issued over a 15 day period in December 2019, averaging 9.2 per day.

What do I do when the school bus stops and the flashing lights come one with the stop sign out?



- Two Lane Undivided Road
 - All traffic in both directions stops.
- Multiple Lane Road with no Physical Divider or Median

All traffic in both directions stops, including the turning lane.

 Multiple Lane Road with Physical Divider or Unpaved Median

Only traffic traveling the same direction as the bus must stop. Traffic traveling in the opposite direction may proceed with caution.
