Meeting was called to order and introductions were made

Dr. Cupit and Ms. Kuntz discussed a project that they have done at a charter school in Galveston. FLASK for 5th Graders: A Grant Funded, Academic, Practice and Community Partnership for Nursing Research. FLASH is an evidence-based, family life and sexual health education curriculum adjusted for various developmental stages of life.

UTMB was asked details regarding the program and content. It was discussed in the meeting and Dr. Cupit agreed to e-mail the program. SHAC will review and share a copy of the detailed program with Dr. Wall, Dr. Shuman, and Ms. Hanssard. A scheduled meeting will be planned if needed.

The nursing department has implemented some changes in documentation by better utilizing Skyward. The high school and Jr. High clinics are entering all student visits into Skyward. This includes injury reports and medications. Kubacak is only entering students that they send home and injuries. RJW is entering injury reports. This is still a work in progress. We have talked with IT about computer stations that will allow students to sign in to the clinic themselves.
