Why was a bond called?

1. Growth

Over the last five years, the Santa Fe ISD community has continued to grow as the population growth ring continues to ripple south from Houston. Current enrollment and potential planned residential developments validate the immediate need for a new elementary school.

2. No Tax Rate Increase

Since March, a Long Range Planning Committee has been working to identify and prioritize district facility needs and recommend this bond package. The resulting recommendation is a timely building program with no tax rate increase, as advised by the District's bond counsel.

3. Priority Repairs

The Long Range Planning Committee recommends priority roof and parking lot repairs that can be completed without affecting the tax rate. However, a prioritized list of additional district-wide repairs and needs has also been formulated, and projects will be initiated with any savings from the proposed work. This list of additional needs and/or repairs includes district wide HVAC repairs, technology, and bus purchases which can be reviewed on SFISD's website.

What is the tax impact?

If this bond passes, there is
