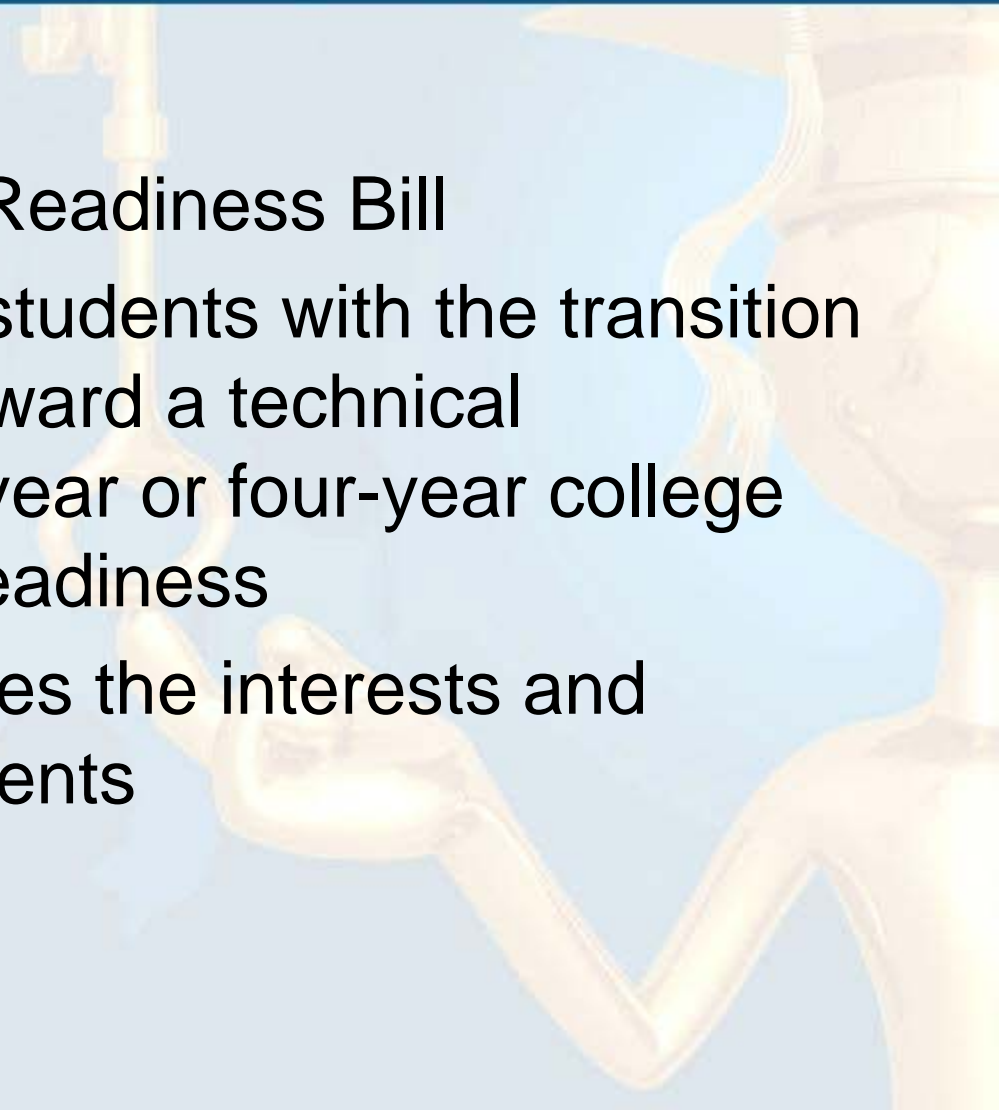




House Bill 5

- What it is:
 - A Post-Secondary Readiness Bill
 - A plan that assists students with the transition from high school toward a technical certification, a two-year or four-year college degree, or career readiness
 - A plan that addresses the interests and aptitudes of all students

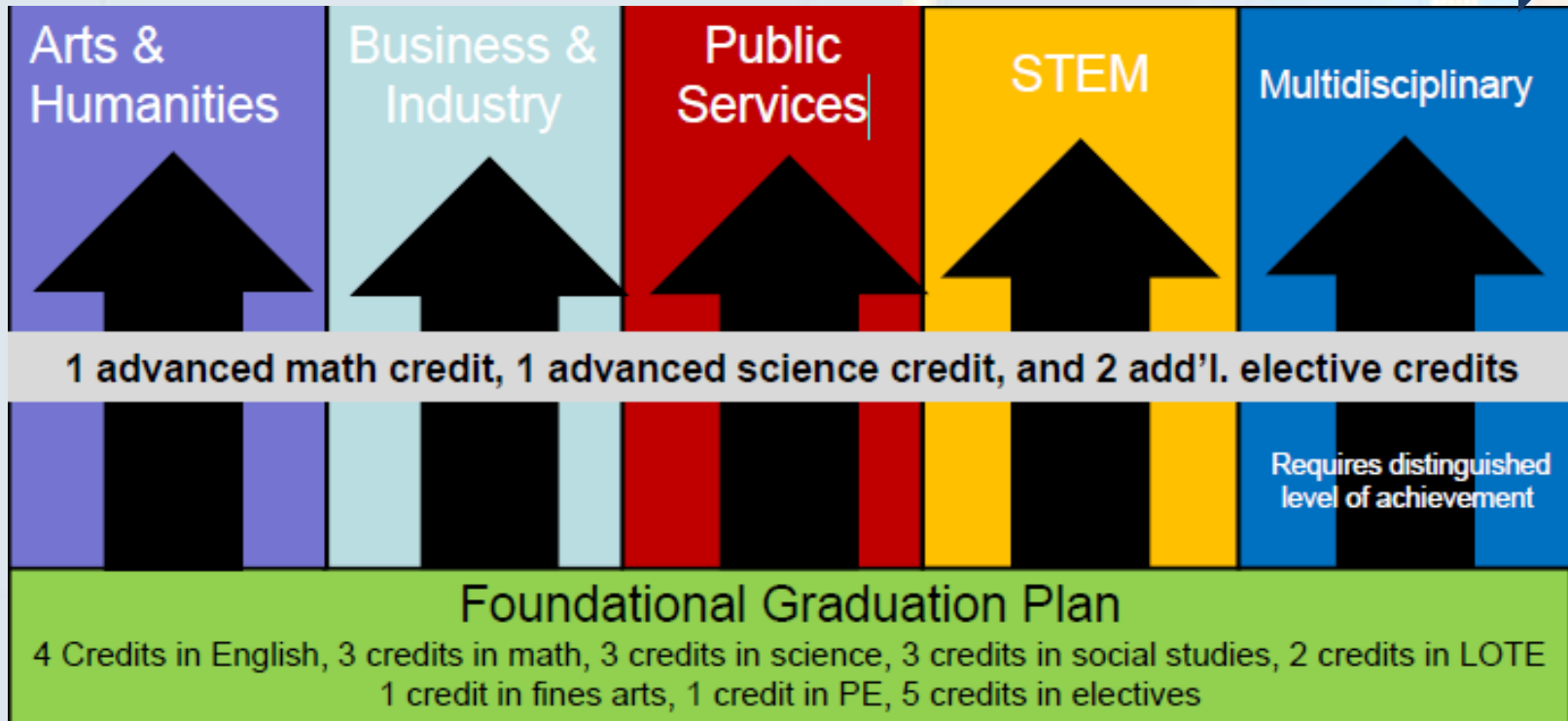


