IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

SCHOOL REPORT CARD: Attached you will find

Kubacak Elementary's school report card from the 2013-2014 school year. Every year the Texas Education Agency releases school report cards in the spring of the following year. The purpose of the school report card is to inform parents about school performance and characteristics.

POPS Party: Students with a conduct and work ethic score of "s" (satisfactory) or higher are awarded a POPS party at the close of the 9 weeks. Please make sure that you discuss the importance of good behavior and work ethic with your child often.

FIFTH GRADE WEIGHT: In order to better prepare our 5th graders for Junior High, grade weight for assessments will increase for the spring semester. Grades will be weighed at 60% of the cumulative grade for daily work and 40% of the grade for tests. If you have any questions, please contact your child's teacher.

HOMEWORK: Please make sure your child is completing their homework every day. Homework assignments reinforce what they are learning on a daily basis.

FAMILY ACCESS: Please continue to monitor your student's grades through Skyward Family Access. If you have questions or concerns, please contact your child's teacher through email or schedule a conference.

ATTENDANCE: It is important that your child is here and on time each and every day. **If your child is absent, please bring them in the next morning at 8:00 to work with their teachers on what they missed that day.**
