At Kubacak Elementary, writing instruction is happening every day! Students learn how to write through a model called “Writer’s Workshop.” Writing skills are developed as they are able to watch the teacher write, write with the teacher, and write independently. Students share their writings with their teacher and their peers as they work through the writing process and gain ideas from one another. Teachers hold “writing conferences” with students so they are able to make individual goals as they develop their writing skills.

Thanks to a grant from the Santa Fe ISD Education Foundation, we are able to present each reading classroom with a new book each month! New books are delivered on the first of every month with directions on how to incorporate the new classroom story into shared reading time! Each book focuses on developing good character.
